Self-pick-up AVISTA OIL Deutschland GmbH

In order to be able to participate in the light-login procedure, the collecting company must be admitted.

The approval requires compliance with the following specifications.

- The application of the Minimum Wage Law (MiLoG) is ensured. Even in cabotage trips according to MiLoG drivers of foreign companies must be remunerated according to the minimum wage law.
- Compliance with the provisions of the Ordinance on International Road Haulage and Cabotage Traffic (GüKG / KabotageV) and all applicable legal requirements.
- Compliance with statutory social legislation.
- The collector ensures that the vehicle technology used meets the legal requirements and state of the art. For tractors, at least the Euro V emission standard is required.
- Respect the behavioral and safety rules of the refinery.
- The employed drivers have sufficient language skills to communicate with the staff at the refinery.
- The vehicles have sufficient insurance coverage.
- Conducting a business partner check with the forwarding companies using the following sanction lists in their current version:
 - US_DPL U.S. Bureau of Industry and Security - Denied Persons List
 - US_SDN U.S. Treasury - Specially Designated Nationals List
 - EU_CFSP Common Foreign & Security Policy
 - DE_IRAN Iran-Embargo-Verordnung (BAFA)

Optional: JCH_SECO SECO-Liste Switzerland, GB_BOE Bank of England - Sanction List

The business partner review is to be conducted once a quarter.

AVISTA is entitled to inspect the vehicles and the drivers used with regard to the implementation of the aforementioned requirements. Upon request, the evidence must be provided to AVISTA.
